

## Officiating Pedigree Analysis – FUTURE BROODMARE SIRES

Blame has sired a very smart one in the shape of Mrs Sippy out of an Encosta de Lago mare and with that stallion being a son of Fairy King it is little wonder this cross is working with Officiating already line-bred to this family via Blame and Sadler's Wells (Fairy King's full brother).

Encosta de Lago's son Northern Meteor is of particular interest as he is also from this family. His sons **ZOUSTAR** and **DEEP FIELD** are good for Officiating - the former being out of a mare by Redoute's Choice who is bred on the same Danzig/Nijinsky cross as Blame whilst the latter is out of a mare by Elusive Quality from the Frizette family which is a strong influence in Officiating's pedigree.

Also of interest from this sire line is **RUBICK** out of a mare bred on a Danzig/Nijinsky cross.

With Officiating line-bred to Special, mares who also have a cross are of interest - such as daughters of **PIERRO** who is 6 X 5 Special via Nureyev and Sadler's Wells. Or those by **DUNDEEL** who is 4 X 5 Special via Sadler's Wells and Nureyev. He is by High Chaparral whose second dam sire Kris is a full brother to Officiating's fourth dam sire Diesis and another High Chaparral horse of interest is **TORONADO** whose third dam sire Sassafras hails from the same Schiaparelli family as Shantung - dam sire of Col Pickering, in turn dam sire of Officiating's second dam sire Horse Chestnut.

**STAR WITNESS** is a lovely member of the Nureyev sire line and his dam sire Lion Hunter is a member of the prolific Queen Mary family - one which strongly influences Officiating's pedigree via strains of Prince Rose, Deputy Minister and Vice Regent. And his second dam sire is Last Tycoon from the family of Shantung.

Written Tycoon line horses are of interest as well - he has a lot of Marscay (dam sire of his sire Iglesia) about him and that horse has always combined well with Blame's great grandsire Roberto; a combo that provides for duplications of the excellent mares Forteresse and Plucky Liege. **CAPITALIST** is out of a mare by Fusaichi Pegasus who has combined with Blame in only seven runners - but five of those are winners.

Street Cry hails from the same female line as Officiating and one of his most in-form sons **PRIDE OF DUBAI** is out of a Danehill mare - a line which looks nice for Officiating with its members **ALL TOO HARD** and **SHAMUS AWARD** also worth having a look at.

All Too Hard is out of a mare by Queen Mary's descendant Desert Sun whose grandsire Green Desert is closely related to Blame's sire Arch, providing for a cross of the lovely mare Courtly Dee. And the W.S Cox Plate winner Shamus Award is line-bred to the great Nijinsky (Blame's second dam sire) and loves further strains with seven of his stakes winners bred that way. Plus his dam sire Success Express is a member of the same Livie family as Omaha, Johnstown and Flares who all appear in Officiating.
